DATA NOTES

UK only. The reduction in our Considerate Constructors Scheme (CCS) average score is largely due to this year's projects being primarily smaller sites where there was less direct contact with neighbours, combined with less construction activity and fewer CCS audits. This year's score is comprised of Broadgate Estates' refurbishment of its central management office at Regent's Place and a retail development. No London office developments undertook Considerate Constructors Scheme audits.
